**SACRED GROUND: A Film-based Dialogue on Race and Faith**  
**Every other Monday, 7:00-8:30 p.m. on Zoom**  
**September 13-November 22; continuing January 10-February 21**

*Sacred Ground* (<https://www.episcopalchurch.org/sacred-ground/>) is a 10-session, film and readings-based dialogue series on race, grounded in faith. Small groups are invited to walk through chapters of America's history of race and racism, while weaving in threads of family story, economic class, and political and regional identity.

Sacred Ground requires a commitment of about 2 hours of reading, film watching, and reflection between sessions, so the 10 sessions will be held every other week (with a break for Advent and Christmas). This provides for open and deep conversations and exploration in small dialogue circles where discussions are kept confidential; and shared Scripture and prayer in a larger group.

**Interested in Sacred Ground but want to learn more before signing up?** There will be an **Introduction/Preview session, on Zoom, Monday, August 30, from 7-8 p.m.**, led by the Rev. Maria Tjeltveit. The session will give an overview of the series, share a preview of one of the films, and invite discussion in a "dialogue circle"; giving a taste of what a regular session would be like.
